(b) Read the short lecture below and take down the notes :

Jaundice is a condition that discolours the skin and the whites of the eyes with a yellow pigment. It is caused by an excess of bilirubin in the blood stream. Bilirubin is a by-product of the break-down of ageing red blood cells. There are three types of Jaundice : hepatic, obstructive and haemolytic. Hepatic jaundice is a disease in which liver cells are damaged. In obstructive jaundice the bile ducts are blocked by stones. In haemolytic jaundice increased breakdown of red blood cells and the release of haemoglobin in excessive amounts swamps the liver.
